ACTION: Chair Gilbert will send a thank you to all of those involved in the presentation








### Mathematics Learning


Math has its own language that students must practice using. In math students learn to communicate what they understand through various representations. They must be able to justify their thinking and show what they know.

#### **ALL Students**









